- Each nominated student will have the option to compete with the Student of the Year from each of the other schools for the overall MCCA Student Chef of the Year Award.* (*In order for that student to be promoted to the ACF Regional and National Level by the MCCA, they must meet the ACF National age eligibility requirements. They must be no more than 25 years of age on June 1, 2019.) The MCCA Student Competition date is Thursday, August 24, 2017 at Dorsey Culinary Academy – Waterford/Pontiac Campus beginning at 12:00 Noon, and will run concurrently with the Chef of the Year Competition. The Student competition is **Category SK1 Chicken or SP1.**
- Individuals cannot have previously have received this award.
- Should exemplify the Culinarian's Code.

This year's award dinner will be held Monday, October 9, 2017 at Country Club of Detroit in Grosse Pointe Farms, MI, hosted by Brian Beland, CMC, and presented by 2016 Chef of the Year, Chris Johnson.
